Children's Ibuprofen Dosage Chart

DO NOT GIVE TO PATIENT'S UNDER 6 MONTHS OF AGE

Repeat every 6 – 8 hours as needed or as recommended by your healthcare provider

Weight	Infant Drops (50 mg/1.25 mL syringe)	Children's Liquid * 100 mg/ 5 mL	Children's Chewable Tablets (50 mg tablets)	Junior Strength Caplets or Chewable Tablets (100 mg tablets)
6 - 11 lbs. / 2.7-5 kg	½ syringe (0.625 mL)			
12-17 lbs / 5.4-7.7 kg	1 syringe (1.25 mL)	½ teaspoon (2.5 mL)		
18-23 lbs / 8-10.5 kg	1 ½ syringe (1.875 mL)	¾ teaspoon (3.75 mL)	1 ½ Tablets	
24-35 lbs / 11-16 kg	2 syringes (2 x 1.25 = 2.5 mL)	1 teaspoon (5 mL)	2 Tablets	1 Tablet
36-47 lbs / 16.4-21.4 kg		1 ½ teaspoons (7.5 mL)	3 Tablets	1 ½ Tablets
48 - 59 lbs / 22-27 kg		2 teaspoons (10 mL)	4 Tablets	2 Tablets
60 - 71 lbs / 27.2-32 kg		2 ½ teaspoons (12.5 mL)	5 Tablets	2 ½ Tablets
72 - 95 lbs / 33-43 kg		3 teaspoons (15 mL)	6 Tablets	3 Tablets
Over 95 lbs / >43 kg		4 teaspoons (20 mL)	8 tablets	4 Tablets

95 lbs/43 kg. and over - May use 2 regular strength (200 mg) adult ibuprofen tablets/capsules.

*** USE ORAL SYRINGES OR SUPPLIED MEDICINE CUP TO MEASURE LIQUID (100 MG/ 5 ML)
- NOT HOUSEHOLD TEASPOONS WHICH CAN DIFFER IN SIZE**
